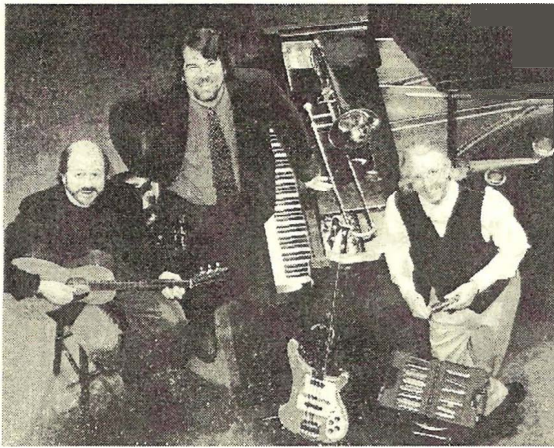

Gene will serve as adjudicator and clinician working with all participating student jazz bands.
